

C.I.E logo jacket or white, black, or red- must be school colors.


Shoes

Hats, caps, and jacket hoodies are not allowed inside the school building.





Uniform and ID Badges

- School IDs must be worn at all times. IDs will be issued on August 18th (Picture Day). Replacement IDs are \$5.00 each.
- School uniforms are worn EVERYDAY. Red, Black and White Cambridge polo tops or White Oxford button down tops with logo and Black pants/skirts only are allowed. For more information, please visit our website at ciecambridge.net. Uniforms may be purchased online or visit store front at Ibiley Uniforms.
- No shorts, skirts above the thighs (must be knee length); Leggings, jeggings, or sweatpants ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Uniform and ID Badge

- Jackets, sweaters and sweatshirts must be **SOLID** (small, school appropriate graphic is acceptable) school colors of Red, White or Black. If sweatshirts have a hoodie attached, STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WEAR HOODIE.
- Students MUST wear their uniform shirt under jacket, sweater or sweatshirt at all times. Students out of uniform will be issued a detention.
- Outerwear is available at Ibiley.com. Students must be in school uniform starting August 14th, 2025.

Attendance and Tardies

• After five (5) or more consecutive absences within the school year, each student will be required to provide a written statement from a health care provider. Documentation must include all days the student has been absent from school.

• A student accumulating five (5) or more unexcused absences for a semester course or ten (10) unexcused absences for an annual course will be subject to the withholding of final passing grades and must resolve the absences.

Attendance and Tardies

- If a student misses one day of school, he/she will be expected to take tests and/or turn in any assignments on the day he/she returns to school with an excused note.
- The student is responsible to present the absent/doctor note to the MAIN OFFICE and get an excused admit to present to their teachers and ask for any missed assignments within 72 hours via in person or at 7021attendance@dadeschools.net

Attendance and Tardies

- After 7:30 a.m., a parent must escort his/her child into the building for a tardy admit. CIE has a closed campus policy. Students must stay on school grounds from the time they arrive until dismissal.
- Students will be dismissed early through the Attendance Office. Any individual signing out a student MUST be on the Emergency Contact Card and present a valid picture identification. No early dismissals after 1:50 p.m.

Technology Usage

Cell Phone usage/Tablets/ Internet Policy and Responsible Use of Technology:

- You may bring your own device (BYOD) or check out a district issued laptop for the year. If checking out a district issued device, it is highly recommended to get the laptop insurance for a minimal fee.
- Laptops are to be used for classroom usage. Cell phones will no longer be permitted unless instructed.
