CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5)(d). Handwashing sinks are properly equipped with hand soap, individual disposable towels or hand drying device, and signage; and conveniently located.

Violation #54. Garbage & refuse disposal

Keep the lid of the garbage container, located outside the kitchen, closed all the times.

Provide a missing plastic drain plug at the bottom of the recycle dumpster, located outside the kitchen.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Garbage shall be disposed of to prevent vector harborage. Trash cans will be durable, cleanable, leak proof, insect and rodent resistant, and non-absorbent. Outside storage area shall be of a smooth, non-absorbent material and sloped to a drain.

Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, & clean

Clean to eliminate some black spot on the ceiling vent in the storage room.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.
